

The Barnett and Jean Hollander Rich Summer Mathematics Internship

Description: The Rich Scholarship program will support students in advanced study of mathematics under faculty supervision during the summer 2018. Students wishing to pursue advanced study under CCNY Mathematics faculty supervision should obtain a commitment from a faculty mentor before submitting an application.

Award: Up to \$8,000 (pending upon cost of attendance limit set by CCNY) for ten weeks during the summer of 2018 and will be given in three payments throughout the Summer. At the conclusion of the internship, participants are expected to submit a written report approved by their mentor, of no less than three pages, describing the nature of their summer work and summarizing their accomplishments. This report is due by August 10th, 2018, and the third payment for the scholarship will be made once you submit the report.

An additional \$250 will be given if a poster is presented at the CCAPP Annual Poster Presentation event in November 2018, but is only available for undergraduates. This event would be a chance for you to present your work to various faculty and students at CCNY. Faculty mentors will receive an honorarium.

Benefit: Students will receive a key to use NAC 6/270 to study and perform their research throughout the summer, but must return the key at the end of the 10 weeks. It will begin June 4th and end August 9th

Eligibility:

1. Minimum GPA of 3.0, but preferred Math GPA of 3.5 or higher in advanced courses completed at CCNY.
2. Two letters of recommendation from CCNY Mathematics Department faculty.
3. A paragraph describing what you will be studying under the supervision of your faculty mentor.
