Department of Mathematics Internship Award Application

The Dr. Barnett and Jean Hollander Rich Summer Mathematics Internship

Description: The Rich Summer Internships are awarded to eligible upper division mathematics majors or Master's students to support summer activities that enhance the applicant's mathematics education. This award is competitive, and the awardees will be selected by the CCNY Mathematics department from the pool of eligible applicants. Eligible activities include faculty-supervised advanced study or research projects with a mentor either at CCNY or elsewhere, as well as otherwise unpaid internships that are related to an advanced topic in mathematics. If you do not currently have a mentor but are interested in an internship, please contact Jason Redman at jredman@ccny.cuny.edu by May 10th, 2021 for details on available projects/mentors. The mentors may include alumni in areas outside the expertise of our current faculty. **The internship will begin June 7th and finish August 13th, 2021**.

Award: \$6,000 for ten weeks will be given in two payments: one half at the beginning of the summer and the remaining half at the end of the summer contingent upon successful completion of the agreed upon project. At the conclusion of the internship, participants are expected to submit a written report approved by the mentor describing the nature of the summer work and summarizing its accomplishments. This report is due by August 20th, 2021.

Mentors will receive an honorarium.

Online Component: Students will be expected to work with their faculty mentors remotely via software determined by the faculty mentor.

Eligibility:

- 1. Minimum GPA of 3.0, but preferred Math GPA of 3.5 or higher in advanced courses completed at CCNY.
- 2. Upper division mathematics majors (60 credits or above) and Master's students who have completed at least 12 credits of Master's level courses by the beginning of the internship.
- 3. Students graduating at the end of Spring 2021 may also apply.

Application Deadline: May 15th, 2021

To Apply:

- 1. By the application deadline, complete and submit the attached Rich Summer Internship Application Form to Jason Redman at jredman@ccny.cuny.edu.
- 2. Give the attached Rich Summer Internship Recommendation Form to each of your two faculty referees after filling out the top portion and signing it yourself. At least one of your recommendations should be from a CCNY Mathematics Department faculty member.
- 3. Obtain a written commitment from your proposed mentor including a description of the expectations for the student over the course of the summer internship and attach it to your application.
- 4. If you are applying to work on a project that Jason Redman provided, in place of item 3., please include a brief description of your past studies, current interests and future plans, and how these align with the expertise of the mentor or project of interest.
