The Barnett and Jean Hollander Rich Summer Mathematics Internship

Description: The Rich Scholarship program will support students in advanced study of mathematics under faculty supervision during the Summer 2024. Students wishing to pursue advanced study under supervision of CCNY Mathematics faculty, as well as faculty members from other institutions, should obtain a commitment from a faculty mentor before submitting their application. The internship will start June 3rd and finish August 9th, 2024.

Award: \$6,000 for ten weeks during the summer of 2024 and will be given in two payments. The first payment will be made to awardees at the beginning of the program. At the conclusion of the internship, participants are expected to submit a written report approved by their mentor describing the nature of their summer work and summarizing their accomplishments. This report is due by August 23rd, 2024. The second payment will be made after this report is submitted and only if the mentor confirms the awardee has met the expectations.

Faculty mentors will receive an honorarium.

Online Component:

Students may be expected to work with their faculty mentor remotely via software determined by the faculty mentor.

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicants must have been enrolled as students at CCNY during 2023-2024 academic year. Students who graduated in Fall 2023 or who expect to graduate in Spring 2024 can apply.
- 2. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0. A GPA of 3.5 or higher in advanced Math courses completed at CCNY is preferred.
- 3. Applicants have to secure two letters of recommendation from CCNY Mathematics Department faculty.
- 4. Applicants have to provide a paragraph describing what they will be studying under the supervision of their faculty mentor. The mentor should also submit a description of expectations of the student over the summer internship.
